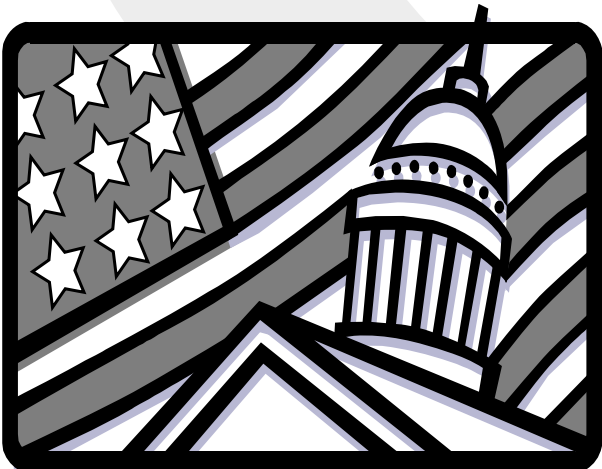

4-H Citizenship, Leadership & Service (CLS) programs promote civic action, respect of differences and life skills with educational opportunities for youth aged 5 to 19.

These programs help demonstrate to young people how their actions today—such as voting, participating in community service projects, writing letters to legislators and decision makers—can make a difference in how their government and their communities function.

By taking part in 4-H, young people can acquire the citizenship, leadership and life skills they need to achieve their potential and to work with others in achieving individual, group and community goals. Key skills developed in youth citizenship and leadership education include developing teamwork and organizational skills and increase in understanding of their roles as citizens.
