

# Teens Talk About Bullying

*Produced by 4-H Youth Development, Michigan State University Extension*

Bullying is an issue of high concern for many young people – and for the adults in their lives. Bullying behaviors have consequences for everyone, including those who are bullied, those who do the bullying, and those who witness these behaviors and worry about their own safety and well-being.

*Teens Talk About Bullying* is a video program designed to help adults and young people aged 12 and up explore *everyone's* responsibility to find ways to deal with this issue. The program uses four brief video segments to explore the thoughts, experiences and wisdom of young people from around Michigan:

- Segment 1: Attitudes Toward Bullying
- Segment 2: Bullying Experiences
- Segment 3: Anti-Bullying Strategies
- Segment 4: Creating Positive Change

The videoguide provides a model for using the videotape for a one-hour session in which you can introduce the topic of bullying and the range of bullying behaviors and help participants examine their own attitudes about and behaviors related to bullying. In this session, you can also encourage discussion and deepen understanding of issues related to respecting human differences and prejudice, and explore ways to create positive and caring environments.
