4-H PUBLICATIONS

4-H publications, which are listed in numerical order, are available to county MSU Extension offices through the MSU Bulletin Office, Michigan State University, 10-B Agriculture Hall, East Lansing, MI 48824-1039. In addition to the publication number and title, a brief description of each publication is included, along with its length, the date it was developed and the name of the developer. For up-to-date information on the availability of 4-H publications, consult the CEENet database, which is available in each county MSU Extension office, or visit the *MSU Extension Educational Materials Catalog* on the World Wide Web at <http://ceenet.msue.msu.edu/bulletin/ctlgmast.html>.

In a few cases, publications are listed that are available on loan or in limited quantities from the State 4-H Office. Please contact the 4-H staff for the respective project area when requesting copies. Other publications are listed as being available on loan from the county MSU Extension office. These generally include things such as notebooks that have been discontinued but are still on the shelf in the county office.
